m Pageant Schedule & Requirements

Friday, November 7, 2025 - Annual Auction & Dinner

- Location: Hyatt Regency San Antonio Riverwalk, San Antonio, TX
- Arrival Deadline: Before 2:30 PM
- Mandatory Contestant Meeting: 3:00 PM (details on meeting location will follow)

That evening, you will be introduced during our **Annual Auction & Dinner**. The dress code is casual—jeans or cute pants are recommended. Each contestant will be provided with a TWA t-shirt to wear and will assist with the auction, so please wear **comfortable shoes** for this portion of the evening. This is a non-judged portion of the contest, but the judges will still observe contestants.

Example 2 Convention Theme: Fiesta Sandia

This year we're celebrating the vibrant culture of the Alamo City and the colorful spirit of watermelon!

Saturday, November 8, 2025 – Competition Day Morning:

- **Speech Competition:** Prepare a brief speech (2-3 minutes) designed to show off your personality so our members can get to know you better. Use this time to show the judges what drives you and how you will make a good representative for our organization.
- **Impromptu Question:** You'll answer a surprise question on the spot, following your speech. The same impromptu question will be given to all contestants.
- Promotional Wear Competition: Choose an outfit suitable for one of the following settings:
 - o In-store promotion
 - Festival appearance
 - Congressional visit

For your **speech**, we recommend a professional dress or suit. You may wear the same outfit for promotional wear or change into another appropriate outfit.

Afternoon:

• **Judges Interviews:** You may wear your speech attire if it's professional. Panel will include at least 3 judges and last roughly 10 minutes.

Evening:

• Evening Gown Competition during our Annual Banquet.

- **Hotel Accommodations:** The TWA will provide a shared hotel room at the Hyatt for **Friday and Saturday nights**. If you plan to stay with a family member or have alternative arrangements, please notify us ASAP.

- Travel Stipend: The first 10 contestants to submit their forms will receive a \$500 stipend, paid at the conclusion of the pageant.
